

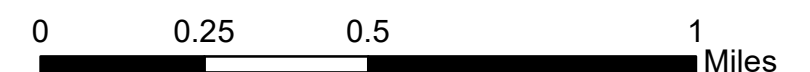
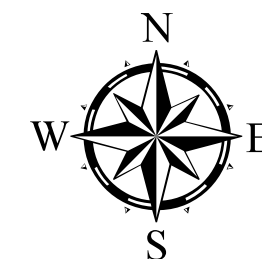
MAP D-5b: Nuisance Flooding

Nuisance flooding, often referred to as high-tide or sunny day flooding, is the overflow or excess accumulation of ocean water at high tide that covers low-lying areas, and typically occurs when tides reach 1.75 to 2 feet above the daily average high tide (NOAA).
