CAMPING RULES

To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all visitors, please observe the following rules:

- **Primitive Camping Only:** No electricity or water at campsites. Tent camping ONLY. No RV's or campers allowed.
- **Permits:** Limited to two camp sites per person per night. All five campsites may not be rented out by the same individual or organization/group.
- **Events:** Private special events, festivals, or gatherings that exceed total campsite capacity (64) are prohibited.
- **Quiet Hours:** 10 p.m. to 7 p.m.
- **Alcohol & Smoking:** Alcohol consumption and/or smoking, is not allowed in City Beaches, Facilities, and Parks.
- **Fires:** Allowed only in designated fire pits or rings.
- **Motorized Vehicles:** Including golf carts, dirt bikes, or ATV's, are not allowed in/on trails. Motorized wheelchairs are permitted where accessible. Only licensed/registered vehicles are allowed in designated parking areas only.
- **Pets:** All pets must be leashed and under control. Owners must clean up after their animals.
- **Preserve Sharing:** Respect other visitors, including paddlers, fishermen, and hikers.
- **Tree Protection:** Do not attach anything to trees or remove branches/natural materials.
- **Waste:** Use provided refuse containers.
- **Wildlife:** Do not feed wildlife.
- **Emergencies:** Call Atlantic Beach Police Dispatch at **(904) 247-5859**.

Park rangers make periodic visits to the island. Restrooms are available during your stay. Trash is collected at the end of your visit, unless requested otherwise. Campers must be present for extra trash collection.
