Request: Request for a variance to Section 24-252(c) which requires developers to provide access to paved streets for development parcel (one-single family dwelling).

Summary: The property owner (and surrounding owners) seek to eliminate the requirement of a paved road for developed(ing) lots. Begonia Street is segmented by marsh and all three property owners with access to this end of Begonia Street seek to maintain the natural environment of the area without expanding the paving of the roadway.
