

Coyote sightings

December 2013 – Jimmy Hill reported seeing a coyote in Howell Park. The City paid for a trapper to set two traps in the park. No coyote was trapped. (See 13-21614 for details.)

May 31, 2016 – Patti Connor left a message stating that she saw a coyote behind the gas station across the street from Hardees. She saw it when she was feeding feral cats around 9:30 PM.

September 20, 2016 – Patti Connor called again. She feeds feral cat colonies along Mayport Rd. and thinks a coyote is living near Hardees and eating her cats.

October 10, 2016 – Flagged down on Marshview Court by a man stating he saw a coyote at the end of Levy Rd. He showed me a picture of the coyote. I asked him to email it to me and gave him my card with my email; he never did.

October 2016 – Resident at the dead end of Inland way saw coyote trotting up behind her dog that ran inside the house at about 3AM. The coyote ran away upon seeing the resident.

November 5, 2016 – Jimmy Savage left a message saying that saw a coyote running through the 5-way last night headed towards tennis courts.

Dec. 13, 2016 – Tami Roick 2228 Oceanwalk Dr. West saw the coyote behind her house at 4:15 PM.

Dec. 18, 2016 – Citizen video recorded coyote in Howell park during daylight. Coyote ran away upon seeing person.

December 20, 2016- 2308 Ocean walk Dr. W. Mid-day, coyote eating berries in backyard of residence.

January 17th, 2017- 620 Paradise Ct. at NW Meeting, Resident advised that they saw coyote near 1500 Main St. within the last few weeks

Jan 18, 2016 – residents at a Neighborhood watch meeting reported in the past, seeing a coyote around the cemetery on Main St.

Jan 18, 2016 – 849 Sailfish Dr resident said that they saw the coyote walking down the street at about 0515 Hrs.

January 21st, 2017- Resident observed coyote at intersection of 11th St. and Seminole Rd. around 8:30 p.m.

January 22nd @ 3pm – 361 Main Street. Ms. Maureen Shaughnessy saw animal in her back yard. As soon as it saw her, it ran away real fast. She initially thought it was a mangy German shepherd. After looking at pictures of coyotes, she believes that it was actually a thin grayish brown coyote. She does not want any action taken and was not threatened at all by it. She said she does not agree with trapping it at all.

January 24th, 2017 – NBPD officer observed a coyote run from Neptune Beach onto Seminole Road towards Howell Park.

Around January 25th – resident saw coyote on Camelia Street walking westbound in between yards in the 900-1000 block.

Around January 27th, 2017 – resident saw two coyotes running on Begonia Street near the Dagley junkyard.

January 31, 2017 – coyote seen at 4:30 am at 20th/Seminole

February 1st, 2017 – resident observed coyote near Beaches Aquatic Center in early morning hours. Resident yelled at it and it ran away.

February 1st, 2017 around 11pm – coyote seen walking south on Seminole Rd at 9th Street. Resident yelled at it and it ran away.

February 1st, 2017 – resident off of Dutton Island Rd and Sallas Lane has seen 3-4 coyotes living on their property (JSO jurisdiction)

February 1st (around this date) observed a coyote around Adelle Grage Center. Ran off when it saw the human.

February 3rd – coyote observed at Mayport/Wonderwood (JSO Jurisdiction)

February 4th, 2017 @ 10pm, resident saw coyote at the 5 way, then headed down Sherry Drive

February 5th, around midnight – officer observed two coyotes running in Selva Lakes Circle towards the wooded creek area.

February 21st, resident in 1200 block of Camelia St said she heard at least 3 coyotes howling

February 24th, several residents saw 2 coyotes around 6:30am at Live Oak/Saturiba

February 24th, resident observed 4 coyotes on his property in 1800 block of Selva Grande

February 26th, resident observed coyote in her yard in 1800 block of Francis Ave

March 2nd, resident saw coyote near Selva Marina entrance gate

March 5th, resident observed coyote in 2200 block of Oceanwalk Drive.
