



Dog Park Frequently Asked Questions

Where is the Dog Park?

268 Aquatic Drive just off Atlantic Boulevard next to Sunrise Community Church and across from Beaches Aquatic Center.

How do I become a member?

Download a membership form from the City of Atlantic Beach website at www.coab.us/dogpark or pick one up at City Hall, 800 Seminole Road. Provide proof of up-to-date shots and spay/neutering. The membership fee is \$50 per year for the first dog and \$25 for each additional dog, up to three (sales tax will be added to all fees). Memberships are on a calendar-year basis, expiring on Dec. 31 of each year. Member fees are prorated for partial year memberships (see Fee Schedule). No more than three registered dogs may be under the care of one person. Forms may be submitted and fees paid at City Hall.

Are there separate areas for small and large dogs?

Yes, there is a separate fenced, gated area for small dogs, although any registered dog may be in the large dog area at the owner's discretion.

Is there fresh drinking water?

Yes, there is fresh drinking water for the dogs and their escorts (non-filtered, non-chilled tap water).

What amenities are in the park?

Park amenities include a dog rinsing station, fresh water drinking stations, poop bag dispensers, trash cans, and benches. Your dog must be off leash once inside the park. The hours of operations are from 7:30 a.m. to dusk. The park may be closed for maintenance as needed.

Are there restrooms at the park?
